

COMPETITION RULES
„MIODRAG AZANJAC“
INTERNATIONAL FLUTE COMPETITION
Belgrade, March 30 – April 01, 2019.

Article 1.

The Elementary Music School „Vladimir Djordjevic“ of Belgrade (Serbia) organizes the music competition titled **II International Flute Competition „Miodrag Azanjac“**.

Article 2.

The event is addressed to students coming from public and private music institutions/schools worldwide.

Article 3.

The competition will be held in the **Elementary Music School „Vladimir Djordjevic“**, Vatroslava Jagica 5, Belgrade (Serbia) from **30th of March to 1st of April, 2019.**

Article 4.

COMPETITION PROPOSITIONS

Categories and performance duration

Junior category A (born in 2010. and younger) – up to 5 minutes

Junior category B (born in 2008. and younger) – up to 5 minutes

I category (born in 2006. and younger) – up to 8 minutes

II category (born in 2004. and younger) – up to 12 minutes

III category (born in 2002. and younger) – up to 20 minutes

IV category (born in 2000. and younger) – up to 30 minutes

Candidates of all categories perform **free choice program**, within given time limit. At least **one composition** must be played **from memory**.

Note: Secondary school students can't compete with the elementary school pupils. They have to perform in the next category, comprised of older contestants, regardless of their birthdate.

Article 5.

To enter the competition, candidates will have to complete the required **online application form**, given at the official school website www.vladimirdjordjevic.edu.rs

On the day of the Competition, candidates have to show a copy of their birth certificate, as well as copy of the payment receipt for the registration fee (showing candidate's name and last name) to the Competition secretary.

Article 6.
APPLICATION DEADLINE – **March 5, 2019.**



Article 7.
Registration (Donation) Fees

Junior categories – 2.500 RSD.
Categories I and II – 3.000 RSD.
Categories III and IV – 3.500 RSD.

Candidates from other countries should pay their donations when they arrive to Serbia (on the day of Competition).

All donations must be paid to Bank Account of Elementary Music School „Vladimir Djordjevic“ Belgrade, account number: **840-1461666-15**, purpose of payment: **„Donation for flute competition“.**

In the case of candidate's cancellation, the Organizer is not obliged to return the fee payment.

Article 8.
Prizes

1st prize: 95 – 100 points
2nd prize: 85 – 94.99 points
3rd prize: 75 – 84.99 points
Acknowledgement: 70 – 74.99 points



In case that two or more candidates obtain the same number of points, younger candidate will have the advantage.

In each category which has more than one competitor, the competitor obtaining the highest score (and minimum 95 points), will be awarded with special prize named **Laureate of the Category.**

Among Category Laureates from Junior category A and B, I and II category, jury will choose **one candidate**, who will be awarded with special prize named **Elementary Music School Laureate.**

Among Category Laureates from III and IV category, jury will choose **one candidate**, who will be awarded with special prize named **Secondary Music School Laureate.**

In addition to diploma, Laureates may be awarded by cup, as well as other gifts provided by competition's sponsors. Additional awards and gifts are subject to change without notice.

Article 9.

Some of the the winners of the first prizes of each category may participate in the final concert, open to the public, and will execute the pieces chosen by the jury.

Article 10.

The **Jury** of Competition will comprise of outstanding Serbian and foreign flute pedagogists, whose names will be published on our web site one month before the start of the Competiton.

Article 11.

Travel expenses, board and lodging are at the candidates charge.

Article 12.

The Organizer will provide an official piano accompanist, if required by candidate and marked in application form. In that case, candidate is required to send scanned piano score to oms.vldj@mts.rs. This service will be charged an additional fee, in agreement with the Organizer.

Article 13.

The organizer reserves the right to acquire and publish audiovisual material during the Competition, without any compensation for the participants.

Article 14.

The organizer is not responsible for any risks, injuries or damages of any kind suffered by participants during the event.
